CANDIDATES SEEKING EXECUTIVE POSITION WITH FSIN

SASKATOON, SASKATCHEWAN (September 19th, 2005) – The Federation of Saskatchewan Indian Nations (FSIN) would like to officially announce the following candidates who have submitted a formal declaration of their intention to seek election for an Executive position with the FSIN.

Each of the following persons listed has met all the eligibility and deadline requirements as laid out in the FSIN Election Act.

The Candidates, in alphabetical order, for the *Office of Second Vice-Chief* are:

- 1) LONECHILD, Guy I. White Bear First Nation
- 2) SPARVIER, Pat D. Cowessess First Nation
- 3) THOMAS, Ken C. Pelican Lake First Nation

The Candidates, in alphabetical order, for the *Office of Fourth Vice-Chief* are:

- 1) GELOWITZ, Eileen F. Big River First Nation
- 2) JOSEPH, Lawrence Big River First Nation
- 3) SHINGOOSE, Raymond L. Cote First Nation

The election will be taking place in Saskatoon at the FSIN Fall Assembly, October 19th and 20th, 2005. Candidate nomination and speeches will be held on the afternoon of October 19th and voting will begin the following morning, October 20th at 9:00AM until 11:00AM. The results of the first ballot will be announced shortly afterward.

The Federation of Saskatchewan Indian Nations represents 74 First Nations in Saskatchewan. The Federation is committed to honouring the Spirit and Intent of the Treaties as well as the promotion, protection and implementation of the Treaty promises that were made more than a century ago.
