## FSIN OPENS FALL LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

(Saskatoon) The Chiefs of Saskatchewan gather Wednesday, Oct 24, 2007 for their two-day fall Legislative Assembly at TCU Place.

First Nations issues are critical to the future of this province so Chiefs will have the opportunity to hear from the provincial political leaders now going head-to-head in the election and ask the leaders questions.

“With the provincial election in full swing, it provides Saskatchewan First Nations a chance to advance their issues and for political leaders to listen. Together we can find ways to work toward the same goals regardless of who takes office. We need to work cooperatively so First Nations can attain economic independence and build healthy communities,” Chief Lawrence Joseph said.

Another highlight of the Legislative Assembly will be the opportunity to hear from the new Saskatchewan Treaty Commissioner Bill McKnight. Chiefs and the FSIN Executive members will also discuss the financial audits of FSIN’s affiliated institutions.

The Legislative Assembly starts at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday and Thursday. On Wednesday, there will also be an honouring ceremony for the Fond Du Lac Firefighters and the swearing in of a new FSIN Senator.
